



Glyde-In Vaccination Policy – as of 31 January 2022

Glyde-In is committed to keeping our members, volunteers and employees as safe as possible and to reducing the risk of transmission of COVID-19. As a response to the evolving situation in WA, the Glyde-In Management Committee has determined that **all staff, volunteers, members and others attending activities at Glyde-In will need to show proof of vaccination.** In line with government policy, this will take effect from **31 January 2022.**

For enrolment day, **Wednesday 2 February**, if you are enrolling in person we will ask to see your vaccination certificate. If you don't have it with you (on your phone or as a print out), you will need to provide proof of vaccination **prior to commencement of classes on 7 February.**

For those enrolling online, the website will require you to tick a box confirming that you have been vaccinated. You will then need to present your certificate (and ID where relevant) at Glyde-In prior to commencement of classes on 7 February.

Staff/Committee Members will be on hand before each session in week 1 to verify vaccination status in case you have been unable to do so beforehand.

If you are in need of assistance, several libraries are providing one-on-one sessions to help set up the ServiceWA app on your phone. Glyde-In volunteers and IT tutors will also be offering sessions to help with this.

As you will understand this decision has not been made lightly, however we take the responsibility to protect our members very seriously.

We also respect people's individual decisions and, equally, we ask our members to practise non-judgement and to respect individual choice.
